- There is no abstract submission fee.
- Submission of an abstract implies formal commitment by the designated presenting author to register for the conference and to present the abstract. However, registration is not required at the time of submission.
- Abstracts may not be edited/updated after final submission.
- All abstracts should be submitted and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication.
- All abstracts will be reviewed by the Conference Co-ordinator
- All abstracts accepted for presentation will be published in a book of abstracts and on the conference website prior to the conference.
- Your abstract is successfully submitted if you receive a confirmation e-mail. To receive this important communication, please ensure that e-mails from enquiries@nfnm.com.au are not considered as spam by your e-mail provider.
